## Steps to Add Sample Models:

- 1. Download the Sample Model File:
  - 1. Click on the link to download a sample model file.
  - 2. Save the file to your computer. By default, the model file will be saved in your downloads folder.
- 2. Upload the Sample Model into Comparion:
  - 1. Select the target workgroup.
  - 2. Go to the Manage Models tab or go to Home in the new UI
  - 3. Click the "New from File" button.
  - 4. Select the file you downloaded to upload the model.

This process allows Workgroup Managers to browse and select from a library of sample models or templates and add them to their workgroup for further use.
