Compensatory decisions are rational decisions. In compensatory decisions, poor performance of alternatives with respect to some objectives can be overcome with excellent performance with respect to other objectives.

For instance, a plane ticket that costs \$100 more may ultimately be the better choice because it is a direct flight, especially if the priority for the "travel time" objective is higher than the priority for the "cost" objective.
